All art begins with inspiration.

This worksheet is designed to help you figure out what's important to you in creating custom art. You don't need to have answers to all or even most of these questions. This is just to help you begin exploring options and priorities. And I'll be here to guide you through every step of the process.

What is your art/story about?

- Who/what is/are the subject(s) of the art?
- What is the feeling you'd like to convey?
- Are there elements that aren't in the photos but you would like to add?
- Is there a special message you would like to convey?

Collect reference photos

Consider the following:

- The optimal photos have more detail.
- Multiple photos of the same subject.
- Combine people, animals, and backgrounds from different photos into one piece of art.

Where will the art hang?

The configuration of the artwork is influenced by the subjects and composition but also where you plan to hang the final piece.

- Do you have preferences or requirements regarding:
 - Approximate dimensions when framed
 - Orientation: Horizontal/Landscape, Vertical/Portrait, Square
- What colors will we use?
 - Are there special colors to add or avoid?
 - If you know where this will hang, do the colors make sense for the décor?
